

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



# **Infants/Primary Report**

May I remind you of some upcoming programs and events which your child or children may be involved in?

1). Starting on the **14<sup>th</sup> November** for two (2) weeks **Kindergarten and Year 1** will participate in the **swim school** run by Sport and Recreation of NSW. This will be held at the local pool during school time. Children will walk to the pool during the day in groups according to their swimming ability for 40 minute lessons each day. (If the weather is very hot we will use the school bus to take children to the pool). They will be accompanied by a member of staff to and from the pool.



2). Children will be required to have swimmers and a towel every day. This is a wonderful opportunity for children to improve swimming ability and water safety in a program offered with no cost to parents. Thanks to the parents who have returned notes. The enrolment forms were also required to be filled in and sent to school.

3). All **children K-6 will start Friday swimming for sport**. Entry to the pool needs to be brought each week except for students who have a seasonal pass. Students are expected to participate, so swimmers and towel must be brought each week.



4). Some students have commenced participating in the Literacy Centre which started last week. The Literacy Centre runs after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3.00pm till 4.30pm. A group of teachers remain at school and provide extra learning time for students to continue to develop their reading

skills. We know the Centre will benefit students and anticipate it will be part of school activities in 2012. I thank the teachers who have donated their time for this worthy initiative at Brewarrina Central.



5). Children can now have fresh fruit and toast each morning as breakfast Club started last week.Miss Dalla Vecchia has organised this and we have approximately 30 children join in for fruit or toast each day.



The **year 6 farewell** is planned for the **15<sup>th</sup> November**. This farewell recognises the achievements of our year 6 students and the completion of their primary education. 5/6W went to Lightning Ridge last Thursday as part of their unit on Gold. They had a fantastic time in an opal mine and learnt about the tedious and dangerous work in mines. They also had fun at the Aquatic Centre at Lightning Ridge. Mrs Walters, Mr York and Sarah Crabtree commented on the terrific behaviour of each child.

# **Infants/Primary Report cont**



Attendance in the classes from Kindergarten to year 6 continues to improve. We are now recognising children who have excellent attendance every 1 or 2 weeks by giving a snow cone as a reward. We will also provide other rewards for children who have excellent attendance. Last week 62 children from K-6 qualified for the snow cone. Every Friday is known as "ice cream Friday" and for children who attend they receive an ice block after assembly Children need to have 90% attendance each

week or fortnight. Thank you to the parents who continuously support the school by ensuring children attend school unless they are sick or there is a serious family reason.

Cynthia Moore visits parents with absence notes so parents can let her know of any reasons their child was not at school. If a child's attendance is below 70% or there are attendance issues we are required to inform the Home School Liaison Officers. Parents have a legal responsibility to ensure their children attend school regularly or they are in breach of the Education Act (1990). Please let the school know if you are going to be out of town for a few days so we can note the absences for you.

Teachers are preparing reports which will inform you of your child's progress this semester- terms 3 and 4. The report format we utilise has limited space so please don't hesitate to see your child's teacher at any time for an update on their progress. Of course you are always welcome to sit in classes and see the fantastic programs and work your child participates in.





We have changed eating arrangements again. Students in years 5-6 go to the canteen before recess and lunch and collect lunch baskets. The baskets are delivered to each class so children have recess before the bell and do not have to queue at the canteen for food. This has stopped pushing and ensures children have the maximum amount of time to eat during breaks.

In the Ridge we went on a guided tour to see all the sights in the area. We saw the Ridges largest open cut mine, the first opal mine shaft, miner's camps and claims, an underground mine and we went fossicking and found some opal!

During the tour students learnt about the tools that are used to mine, the hardships faced by miners, how it feels to be underground in a mine shaft and what to look for when mining.


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
